

Dress Code Expectations

Dress and grooming must be clean, neat and appropriate for the classroom and all activities. Attire that poses a threat to safety and health or disrupts the educational process will not be permitted. If your child comes to school wearing inappropriate clothing they will be asked to change into the extra clothing we have at the school. Students' appearance should reflect his/her identity as a follower of Christ. The Bible makes it clear that we are to be modest and treat our bodies with the utmost respect. At CCS our appearance code will reflect modesty, appropriateness and neatness. The following clothing does **NOT** meet the modesty, appropriateness and/or neatness standard and is **NOT** allowed:

1. Spaghetti strap or racer back shirts and tops
2. Visible undergarments (including camisoles)
3. Pants and tops that are tight fitting
4. Pants, shorts, dresses and skirts which are shorter than the top of the knee. This standard is in place even when students are wearing leggings. Slits are not to extend above the top of the knee.
5. Hats, sunglasses, hoods, and head scarves are not to be worn in classrooms
6. Shorts that are too big, too long and /or baggy
7. Jewelry not worn in moderation and good taste
8. Messages on clothes that are profane, vulgar, lewd or dishonoring to Christ
9. Pants that drag on the floor and sag
10. Clothing that has excessive rips, tears or holes or where skin can be seen
11. Shirts that reveal cleavage, stomach, or back. Tops and shirts must be long enough to cover the waistline at all times

(*As of now, tank tops are allowed as long as no undergarments are showing the straps are 3 ADULT fingers across).
